What's involved?

Join our team and help create a Christmas to remember as we invite families to see Santa in his underground grotto. We expect over 4000 children to join our Santa boats into the Limestone Caverns.

The Santa visit takes children into our caverns where they first see a pantomime in Singing Cavern; they then go on into Little Tess Cavern which will be Santa's Grotto; as Santa you will be waiting here for them. You will go on to the boat where you will speak to every child and give them a gift. Children will also have the opportunity to have their photograph taken with you.

You will need to be:

- Someone who loves Christmas and has a jolly attitude - happy sharing Christmas magic with all our visitors
- Great with children and be friendly and approachable with all our customers, able to chat to anyone whether they are 3 years or 93 years
- Prepared to go the extra mile to ensure a fun time is had by all
- Able to stay in character for an extended period
- Happy to have your photo taken when in character
- Available to work across a range of hours including evenings and weekends
- Happy to work underground and travel in via a canal boat as Santa's grotto is located in one of our limestones mines
- Someone with similar work experience
- Eligible to work in the UK
- This is a performance role. Character - Male, older and full voice quality, preferable with a playing age of 40+, white. Father Christmas is jolly and positive, with charisma and presence. He embodies the spirit of Christmas.
