This is an exciting time to join us as the Trust looks to review and reposition several of its offers and develop plans and goals that will ensure it remains sustainable, vibrant, and engaging for all.

Duties

- The post holder will monitor the financial administration & health of the charity, and report to the board of trustees at regular intervals, in line with best practice and in compliance with the governing document and legal requirements.
- The treasurer will be involved in budgeting and strategic financial planning, financial and management reporting, risk assessment, risk management and production of annual accounts, and is likely to be involved in areas such as investments, governance, reserves and pensions.
- The postholder will also be expected to act as a signatory for the Trust's finances.
- Contact & meetings with the Trust's Finance Manager and Chief Executive on a regular basis.

Experience of financial management is required, experience of charities and governance advantageous.
